# WHAT IS PROFESSIONAL COUNCIL?

- Standing committee under the AAPM Board of Directors
- Professional Council shall act as a <u>clearinghouse for professional inquiries addressed to</u> <u>the Corporation</u> by members or outside groups and shall <u>route inquiries to the</u> <u>appropriate categorical Professional Committees</u>. The Professional Council <u>shall</u> <u>consider and make recommendations of professional policy to the Board</u>. It shall <u>formulate specific charges for the guidance and direction of the categorical</u> <u>committees</u>.

Bylaws: Article III, Section 5 Rules: 3.7



### WHAT DOES PROFESSIONAL COUNCIL DO?

- Provide overall direction to the committees of the Professional Council and monitor their activities.
- Receive reports from the categorical Professional Committees.
- Approve the appointments and charge of Subcommittees, Task Groups and Working Groups appointed by the categorical Professional Committees.
- Ensure liaison between the committees of the Professional Council and among their respective subcommittees, working groups or task groups.
- Ensure liaison with other Councils.
- Recommend appointments to the categorical Professional Council Committees.
