

RO-ILS basics

- Sponsored by ASTRO and AAPM; free to use
- Uses the structure of an accredited “Patient Safety Organization” to establish federal protections to reports
- Web-based, no special IT infrastructure
- Can use as the local ILS, choose what to push up to national
- Anonymized reports analyzed by volunteer “Health Advisory Council”, “RO-HAC”

- You need to establish a contract with Clarity PSO
 - See “Participation Guide” on ASTRO website
- You have full access to all your data
- You have no access to anyone else’s data
- You receive reports based on national, anonymized data

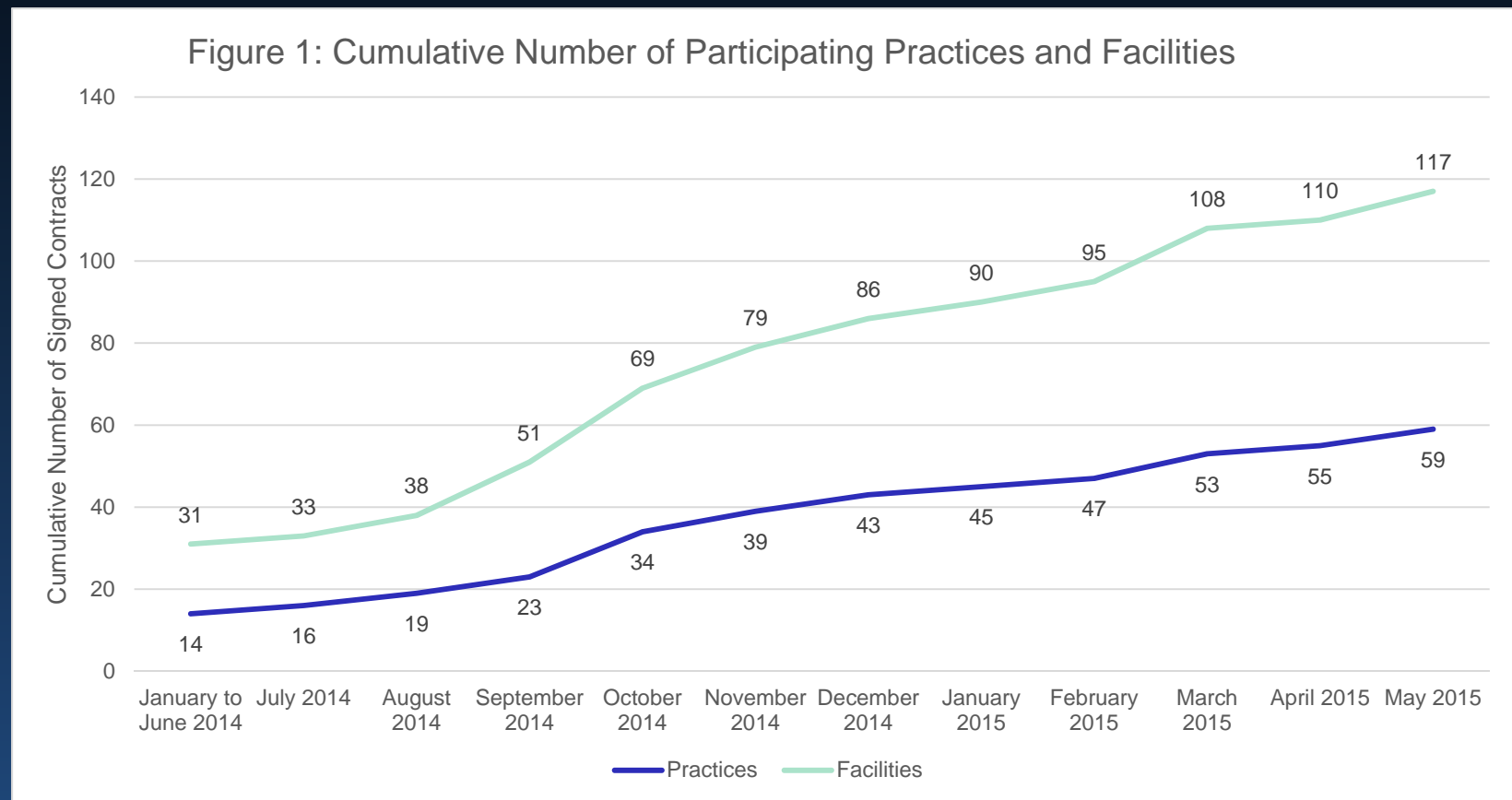
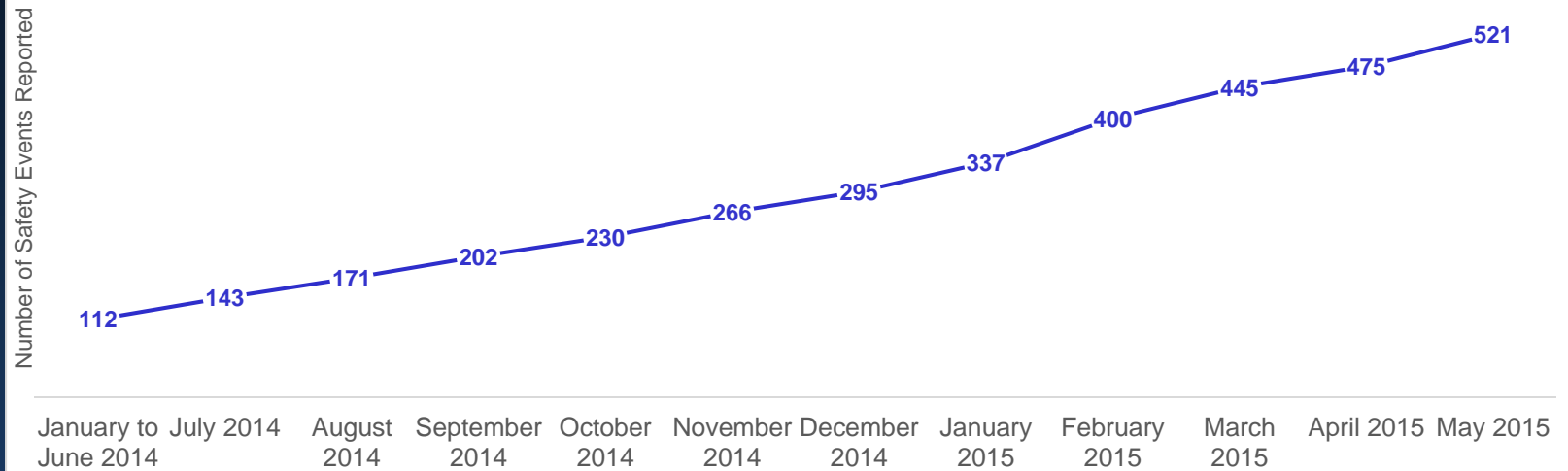


Figure 6: Cumulative Number of Events Reported to Clarity PSO
